Teamwrkx Construction Answers Prayers for Affordable, High-Quality Renovations at Multiple Bay Area Places of Worship

[Teamwrkx Construction](#) is answering the prayers at places of worship throughout the Bay Area by helping congregations find affordable ways to build and renovate their facilities. The company is currently in Phase One of \$500,000 in renovations for the **Canaan Taiwanese Christian Church**. The 15,000 square-foot project requires renovations to the sanctuary, kitchen, Bible study area, classrooms, reception and lobby, as well as Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) upgrades and new HVAC systems. Construction is scheduled to be completed by mid September.

"After only one month of Teamwrkx starting renovations, we are very impressed with how focused they are on project execution and customer service. Meeting our needs is their top priority," said Church Elder Chien Wu. "We are grateful for their display of true teamwork and are happy to have chosen them as our contractor."

The \$4+ million, 77,000-square foot [Korean Emmanuel Presbyterian Church](#) involved rebuilding a vacant office complex into a new church sanctuary for up to 1,000 parishioners, youth sanctuary for up to 400 children, full-service kitchen facilities, multipurpose rooms, conference centers, classrooms, Bible study rooms, daycare areas, an indoor playground, a library, administrative offices and a community bookstore. Although construction took place during the rainy winter months, Teamwrkx completed the project on time, including gutting the existing interior and raising the facility's roof to a height of 26 feet. Additionally, \$1 million in renovations were performed by KEPC volunteers who worked alongside Teamwrkx during the course of the project.

*"When we asked Teamwrkx to blend our hundreds of volunteers with their professional construction team so that we could reduce labor costs, they said 'no problem.' Then, when our unskilled volunteers caused schedule slippages, Teamwrkx again said 'no problem' and stepped in and made up the difference," said **Pastor Wonabe Son**. "They did all of this on budget, without injuries and ahead of schedule. It's wonderful to work with a contractor that understands the importance of conserving church funds."*

For the [Los Gatos United Methodist Church](#), Teamwrkx transformed a 50-year-old gymnasium into a 10,500 square-foot multipurpose youth center. The \$1.5 million renovations included a worship center, an area dedicated to missions, a stage and music room, a labyrinth for meditation, a café and kitchenette, and showers as well as the addition of an ADA-compliant elevator. Throughout the construction, Teamwrkx took special care to ensure that the site remained safe for the toddlers, parents and teachers who attended classes at LGUMC's Grace Preschool Children's Ministry.

"Our plans were not very specific when we put this project out as a blind bid. Teamwrkx Construction came in with an impressive presentation. We were extremely impressed with their sincerity. We got a strong sense that they would do everything within their power to make this project work," said **Senior Pastor Lee Neish**.

The \$1 million [Center of Hope Community Church](#) entailed demolition, renovation and new structural work on an existing 40-year-old building. During construction, Teamwrkx not only dealt with the challenges inherent in an aged structure, but also discovered and repaired several existing problems that had not been previously identified but would have presented issues in the future. Specifically, Teamwrkx demolished the old entry and constructed a new one that included a tower, cross, and a new store-front entry hall. The existing roof was removed and a new one installed. Interior improvements included new marble and granite bathroom facilities, extensive handicap access improvements, custom carpeting, and the removal and reinstallation of reupholstering church pews. This work was done in two phases, each phase taking less than a week so as not to interfere or disturb the church's weekly services.

"We are extremely pleased with the results. Teamwrkx offered innovative and effective leadership in handling complex tasks. We highly recommend Teamwrkx, without reservation, for any project, and especially for places of worship," said **Pastor Brandon Reems**.
